**In order to make the most of your tour, please take note of the following:**

Passports are required for tours crossing the US-Canadian border. For non-US citizens, additional visas may be required. Please ensure you have proper documentation before boarding. Check with your booking agent for details.

- ◆ Wear comfortable, weather appropriate clothing, including comfortable footwear for walking throughout the parks.
- ◆ Our 4 - 5 hour tour time is just an estimate, the actual tour time will vary based on traffic and attraction volume and individual group needs.
- ◆ Due to circumstances beyond our control, certain attractions may be substituted when needed.
- ◆ For a tour or time schedule change please see your booking agent or call our office at (716) 285-2113. If for any reason you need to cancel your tour, we will provide a full refund for all cancellations made 24 hours or more prior to your original tour departure time. **What type of documentation do I need for crossing the border on my tour?**

United States and Canadian citizens ages 16 and older must present one of the following travel documents at the border: A valid U.S. or Canadian Passport, or Enhanced Driver's License (EDL), or U.S. Passport Card, or Trusted Traveler Program Card.

United States and Canadian citizens under the age of 16, or under the age of 19 traveling with a school, religious or other youth group, must present one of the following travel documents at the border: An original or certified copy of birth certificate, or Naturalization Certificate, or Consular report of birth abroad, or Canadian Citizenship Card.

Lawful Permanent Residents of the United States must present a Permanent Resident Card ("Green Card", INS Form I-151) at the border.

Residents of nations other than the United States and Canada may require a Canadian Visa along with their passport to enter Canada or re-enter the US. Contact your national consulate before leaving home. International visitors will require passports to cross the border. Citizens of some countries may require a Canadian Visa as well. Be sure to check with our staff when booking your tour.




